We will go on at least one theme-specific field trip, visit Canal Park for performances, and splashing at the water fountains at Navy Yard. All trips are walked so the children have the opportunity to be outside everyday (weather permitting) and within a 1.5-mile radius of the camp.

Week 1 (June 25 - 29)

Folk Art: Painting, sculpting, drawing. There are endless possibilities when it comes to art. Our artists will practice new vocabulary and go on a colorful exploration while learning about the historical and cultural importance of art.

Week 2 (July 2 - 6)*

Week 3 (July 9 - 13)

Armed Services: This week is dedicated to the heroes that protect and serve us from the branches of the armed services. Our heroes will practice vocabulary, explore fun experiments and make their own parachutes and periscopes.

Week 4 (July 16 - 20)

Creepy Crawlers: Insects, bugs, amphibians, reptiles, and the like...ewww. Are you grossed out yet? Our snuggle bugs will practice vocabulary to learn more about our icky little friends, go on nature walks, and make a little friend of their own to take home.

Week 5 (July 23 - 27)

Space Exploration: Join us as we BLAST off into space to learn about our galaxy and image about the great beyond. Our astronauts will practice vocabulary, explore the Air and Space Museum, and make their own planets.

Week 6 (July 30 - August 3)

Sports: On your MARK, get SET....GOOOOOO! Join the race at our camp to try some of our favorite sports. Our athletes will practice vocabulary, try different sports and games, and tire themselves out in time to go home.

Week 7 (August 6 - 10)

Engineering: Click, bang, and snap; our engineers will be busy at work creating and building as well as learning vocabulary, basic engineering concepts, and making their own creations to take home.

Week 8 (August 13 - 17)
